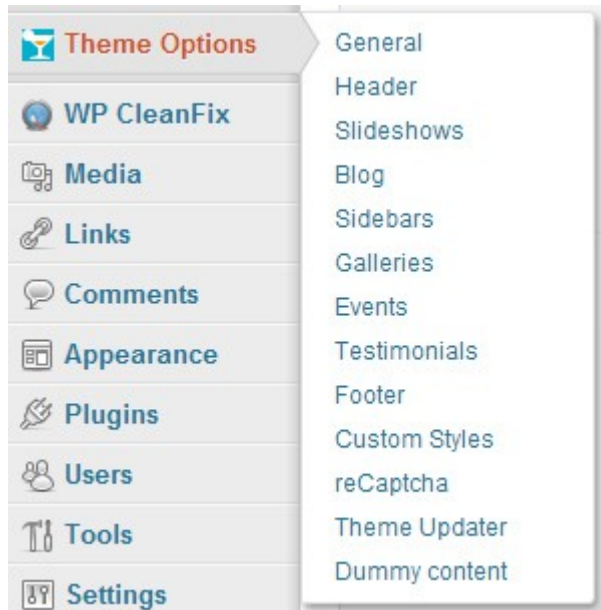

## Custom Styles

Custom Styles option allows you to add custom CSS rules from admin panel instead of editing core theme files.

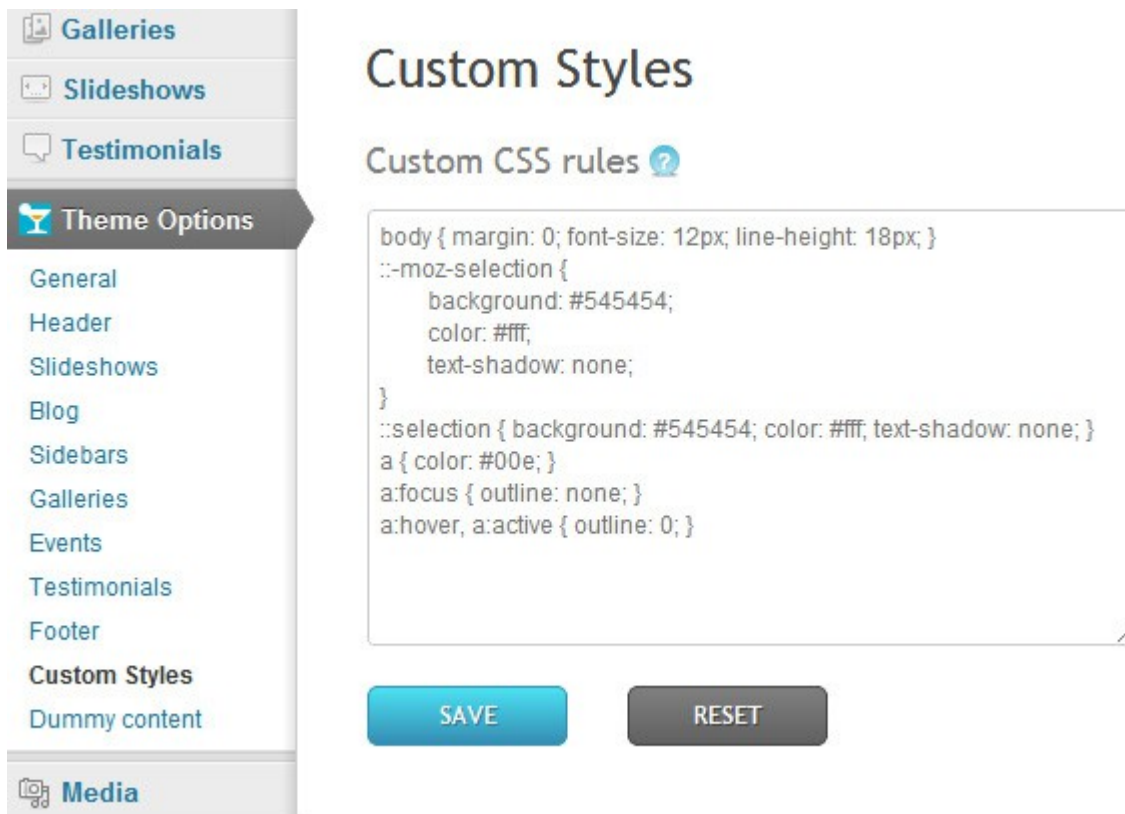
To add Custom Styles navigate to **Theme Options** -> **Custom Styles** page at your Dashboard.



### You can add custom CSS rules from admin panel.

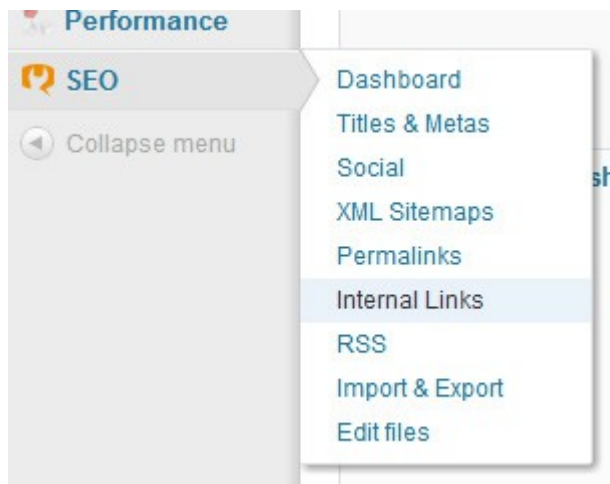
It allows you to change theme look without editing core theme files, instead of editing core theme files.

And what is important, CSS rules are stored in database and will be saved after theme update.



## How to add breadcrumbs

We decided to use “[WordPress SEO by Yoast](#)”, must have, plugin for breadcrumbs. This plugin is free and have a lot of nice features, so we recommend to use it.



Download plugin from official website and install it. After that you will see new menu item “SEO”. You can activate breadcrumbs on “**Internal links**” page of this plugin, **SEO -> Internal Links**. Simply mark checkbox as you can see on the image below and click save settings.



## Translation

Our theme is translation ready. You can translate it to any language or even set multiple languages.
